# WHY IELTS WRITE?

For many, the most difficult section of the IELTS test is the writing section. In one hour, the test taker must write two completely different essays about a variety of topics. Becoming comfortable with the different essay types that may appear on the exam is essential, as is getting feedback on your writing before the test day.

**IELTS Write** allows you to practice the writing exam from the comfort of your own home, whenever you have the time. The essays can either be written in a strict time mode, with the same time limits as the real test, or a more relaxed practice pace (60 minutes for a single task or 90 minutes for a full test). All tests are graded by an IELTS tutor and given feedback based on the same criteria as the real test within two days of submission.

## WHO IS IELTS WRITE FOR?

**IELTS Write** is for anyone planning on taking **the Academic IELTS test** and looking for feedback on their writing.

Though there is no requirement to be a certain level, it is recommended that test takers have at least a **pre-intermediate level** of English to get the full benefit of the product.

## **Task Achievement:**

Were all of the parts of the question answered?

Were all of the elements of the task thoroughly explored?

## **Coherence and Cohesion**

How well were the thoughts and ideas of the essay organized?

Were thoughts and ideas properly linked?

## **Lexical Resource**

What level of vocabulary was used?

Were there any words used incorrectly?

## **Grammatical Range and Accuracy**

Was appropriate, high-level, grammar used effectively?

Were there any errors?
